


Family History Preservation

Family history preservation is a little different for everyone.

Often times it starts with a story or a collection. Sometimes it's after the loss of a family member or before selling a family home. It's about preserving spaces, items, and moments that keep our loved ones alive in our memory. Each preservation session is about capturing a glimpse into who your family truly is.

I was raised on a ranch in SouthEastern Colorado amongst artists and storytellers and I have developed my own mix of both. The images seen here are of my family's history preservation. Captured moments of family and artwork created from the spaces and objects left behind by my ancestors. This is my way of remembering each of them and sharing their story for future generations.
















ABOVE: **MOM IN THE KITCHEN** This is a space mom frequents. I think she loves to cook but like most of us, not always. Being sixty miles from a grocery store does limit your choices though so when mom doesn't feel like cooking...She usually does anyways. **COUNTING COWS** Kelsey, the youngest of the family, spends half of the year helping Dad on the ranch. Here she is counting cattle, making sure the entire herd is accounted for, before she feeds them.

ABOVE: **DAD AT THE FRONT GATE:** Dad has lived on this ranch nearly all his life. He'll never retire like most do since he's always loved his work. He'll push cows until the end. **PARTIAL FAMILY PORTRAIT, 2020:** Every visit I take a family portrait with whoever happens to be home. This image was taken over at the corrals before I started my drive home, before my mother ran mail, and after the guys were done vaccinating. **AT THE BACK DOOR:** Dad says goodnight to his cow dog, Maggie before he calls it a day.


